13 LCM-ers (grad & undergrads) are heading back to Guatemala to help build three homes with Construcasa ([www.construcasa.org](http://www.construcasa.org)). We've been planning since October and begun meeting weekly to learn about Mayan culture, Guatemalan history & poverty.
