




What you need to lead


It takes just minutes to apply to lead a Thrivent Action Team and share your success story after your project. Have the following information at your fingertips to make the process even easier!

Before you apply for a Thrivent Action Team:

- **1.** To apply for a Thrivent Action Team, go to Thrivent.com/actionteam.

 - ☐ Your Thrivent user ID and password.
 - ☐ Estimated project date (Give us 21 days to review your application and send your Action Team kit.)
 - ☐ What you'll do and how the project will help your community.
 - ☐ How your volunteer team will be involved.
 - ☐ How you'll use the \$250 in seed money.
 - ☐ Church or other nonprofit organization that will benefit from the project, if applicable.
 - Number of volunteers on your team and T-shirt sizes.
